Why Is Production Divided into Cells – and What Does It Mean at AMANN Group UK?

Cell production is a modern manufacturing principle in which related tasks are grouped into dedicated “**cells**” — self-contained work units responsible for a specific part of the overall process. Each cell typically has its own team, equipment, and often integrated quality control, enabling a more focused and efficient workflow.

What Does This Mean at AMANN Group UK?

At AMANN UK, the main production departments —Twisting, Dyeing, Bonding, and Final Winding — are organized into clearly defined functional cells. This means:

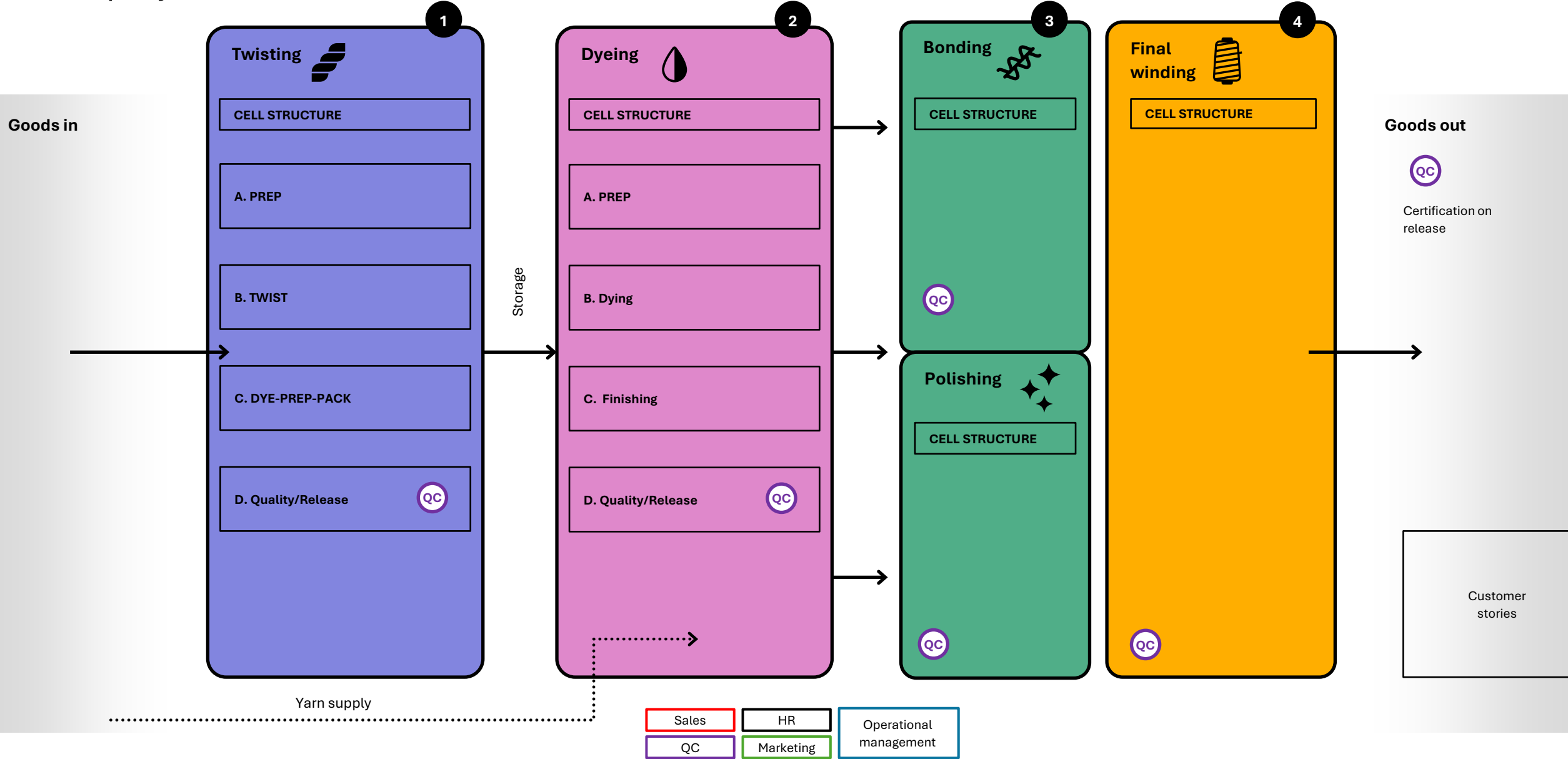
- Clearly separated work zones for distinct process steps

- Smooth material handovers from cell to cell, reducing waiting times

- ✓ Strong foundation for continuous improvement and lean operations

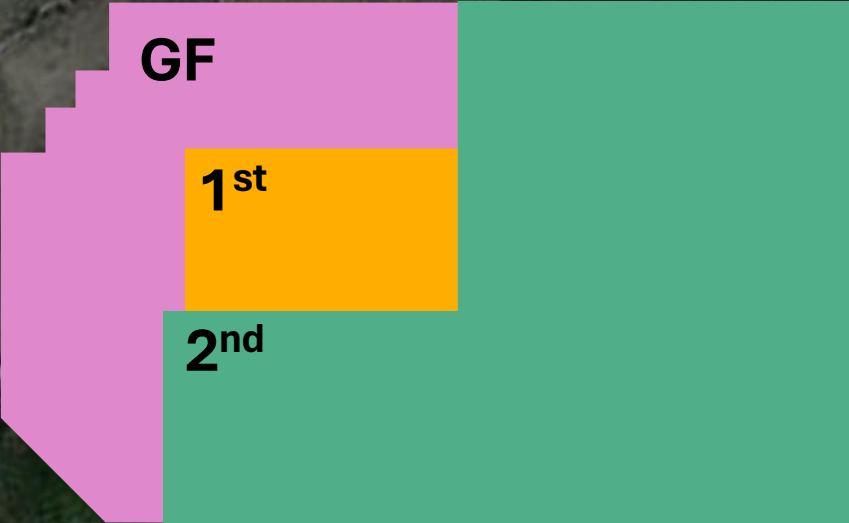
At AMANN UK, each cell operates like a “mini business unit” within the larger production system — playing a direct role in delivering quality and reliability to the customer.

Ground Level 0 – Dye House

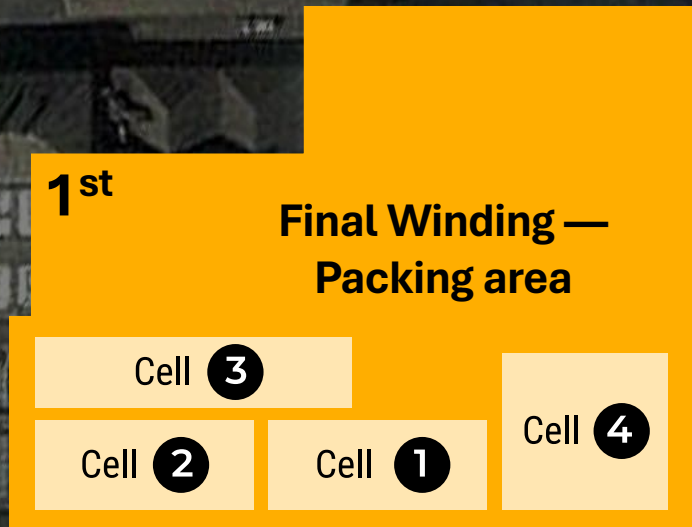
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1. Entrance

5. Quality Department

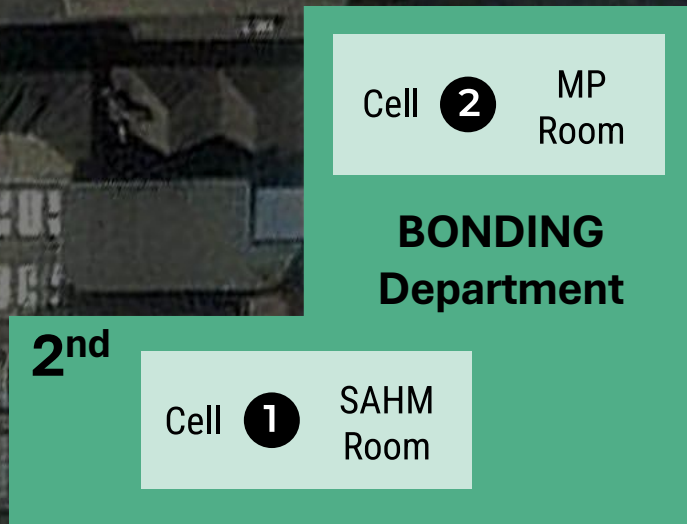
Level 1 – Final Winding
